

How to play

The goal of sudoku is to complete a 9x9 grid with numbers so that each column, row, and 3x3 grid have the numbers 1-9. At the start, the 9x9 grid will have some squares filled in. The goal is to try to fill in the missing numbers and complete the grid. A row, column, and 3x3 grid can only use numbers 1-9 once. So, if a row has a number in it, it can't be used again in that row, even in another column or 3x3 grid. Good luck!


