





They are a professional football club located in Norwich, Norfolk, England where they have played since 1935 after being founded in 1902 before moving to the stadium Carrow Road with a capacity of 27,359 seats. The Canaries have a longstanding and fierce rivalry with East Anglian rivals Ipswich Town. They are currently competing in the EFL Championship as of the 2022-2023 season. 


